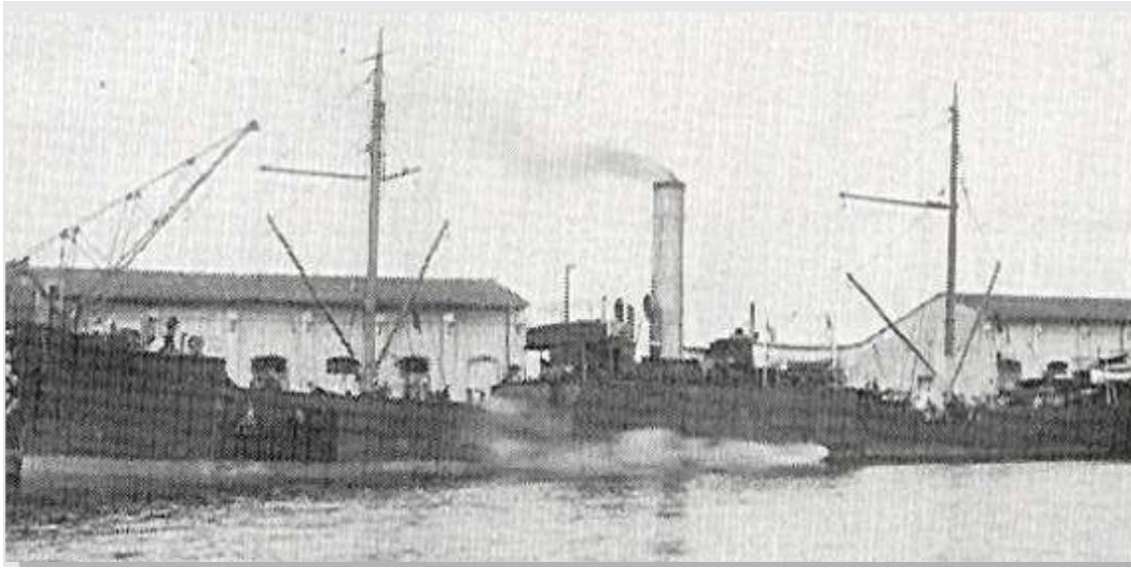


MINORCA



Load Vapor built in 1892 by Ramage & Scottish shipyards Ferguson Ltd, Leith. Launched on August 9. It was the smaller merchant sunk by U64 in the waters of Villajoyosa.

Features:

1.161tn tonnage, length 68 m and beam 11mts.

Sinking:

Was sunk December 11, 1917 by U64 about 2 or 3 miles from Cabo de las Huertas in ballast Geneve-Cartagena route. He was endowed with artillery at the time of its shink.
