Steam used for carrying cargo loads not packaged (grain, coal, etc.) built by the Scottish shipyards of Port Glasgow Clyde Shipbuilding and Engineering Company. She was launched on February 24, 1910..

Features:

2.301tn tonnage, length 76 m and beam 13mts.

Sinking:

With the ship in ballast and making travel to Marseille Melilla low English flag, was attacked and sunk by U64 on December 11 1917 near Villajoyosa. A life was lost.
